- ❖ Continue teaching while you get your Masters degree with both an M.A. and M.Ed. available (applicants must currently have a teaching degree).
- ❖ Learn about adapting the core curriculum and instructing in the expanded core curriculum for students who are blind or visually impaired.
- ❖ Take On-line courses during the school year and face-to-face courses over three summers on UBC's Vancouver campus.
- ❖ Complete your program by August 2021.
- ❖ You may be eligible for financial assistance through the BC Loan Forgiveness Program.
- ❖ Some merit-based scholarship opportunities are available once in the program.
